Supported for installation projects in industrial parks and zones, and for the modernization of establishments located in existing buildings.

**47 - Retail trade, except for motor vehicles and motorcycles (Eligible investment of up to €350,000)**

Installation and modernization projects for commercial establishments located in existing buildings are supported, provided that:

- Are located in urban centers, in areas delimited by Municipal Councils;
- Or Are located in areas that clearly reveal flaws of market.

**56 - Catering and similar - Eligible investment up to €500,000**

Only installation, modernization or expansion projects in existing buildings are eligible for support.
